



Financial Assistance Program 2009/2010 Season

One of many of the goals of FC Las Vegas is to ensure that any child with the desire, commitment and ability to play for one of our teams be given the opportunity regardless of their financial situation. We realize that the costs of competitive soccer can be quite high and we pledge to offer as many fundraising opportunities during the year as possible. Families in need of additional assistance may apply for financial assistance in the form of extended/alternate payment plans or scholarships. Financial assistance funds are limited and will go to those showing the most need, as determined by FC Las Vegas. Financial assistance and scholarship awards are restricted to assist in covering club fees and coaching fees. **All FC Las Vegas players are required to pay for their travel expenses, team tournament fees, uniform package and league fees, even if they qualify for financial assistance.**

In order to be eligible for financial assistance, a player must meet and adhere to all guidelines set forth in the Financial Assistance Application. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of any financial assistance awarded. Financial assistance will be considered for FC Las Vegas Players with illustrated financial need who complete and submit a signed application form before the deadline. Those requesting financial assistance greater than \$500 must qualify for free or reduced lunches according to Clark County School District guidelines and show documentation from the Clark County School District of such. If players do not meet guidelines, they may still apply for a partial scholarship or alternate payment plans. The application form must be filled out completely and received by FC Las Vegas before the deadline for your application to be considered. **The deadline for consideration for financial assistance/scholarships for the '09-'10 soccer year is June 5th for returning FC Las Vegas players and before signing for new FC Las Vegas players. I, _____, attest that the information provided in this application is true and that I am the parent or legal guardian of the player in this application. I understand the following scholarship policies: Scholarships are granted at the discretion of the FC Las Vegas and are not an entitlement. They are awarded solely on the basis on need without regard to sex, race, color, religion, national origin, etc. I also agree to meet all financial obligations, including paying travel expenses, team tournament fees, uniform package fees, league fees and any other fees not included in the financial assistance award. I also agree to participate in all club and team fundraisers. Scholarships are awarded for a seasonal year (July 1 – June 30). If my child is on scholarship and leaves an FC Las Vegas team before the end of the seasonal year ends, I agree to reimburse FC Las Vegas for fees that equal the difference between scholarship tuition paid and non-scholarship fees for the entire seasonal year (July 1 – June 30). Receipt of assistance for one seasonal year does not guarantee help for future seasons.

I also understand that to keep a scholarship, players must meet their commitment to the team and the Club including meeting all financial obligations and attending all regularly scheduled practices, games, tournaments and meetings. Repeated late arrivals at games or practice may be grounds for withdrawal of a scholarship. I also understand that failure to comply with any and all team and club rules, including the Player Code of Conduct and the Parent Code of Conduct may be grounds for withdrawal of scholarship.
